

**South Derbyshire Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places
Public Spaces Protection Order 2017**



Notice is hereby given that South Derbyshire District Council ("the Council") has made the following Public Spaces Protection Order under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act"):

1. The Order may be cited as the South Derbyshire Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places - Public Spaces Protection Order and came into force on 27th day of January 2017 for a duration of 3 years.

2. This Order applies to all land described in the Schedule below being land in the area of the Council to which the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 applies and will be protected by the making of this Order.

Offence

3. In this area any person who continues drinking intoxicating liquor in the Order area when asked to desist by a Police Officer, Police Community Support Officer or authorised person from the Council under section 63 or 69; or fails to surrender any intoxicating liquor in his possession when asked to do so by a Police Officer, Police Community Support Officer or authorised person from the Council under section 63 or 69 commits an offence.

Penalty

4. A person who is guilty of an offence under paragraph 3 of this Order shall under section 67 of the Act be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale or a fixed penalty notice of a fee set by the relevant Council Committee not exceeding a maximum of £100.
